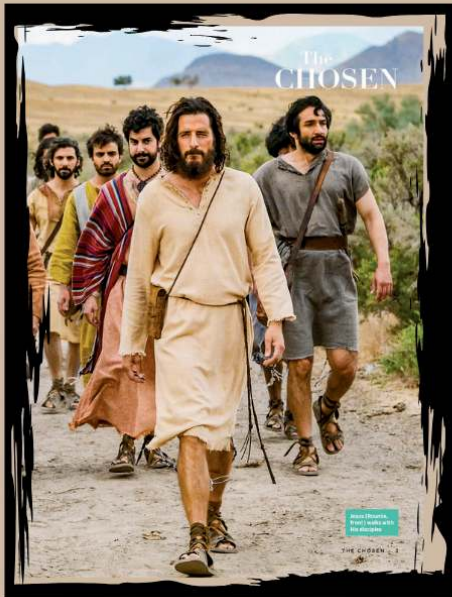
Sunday, June 14th

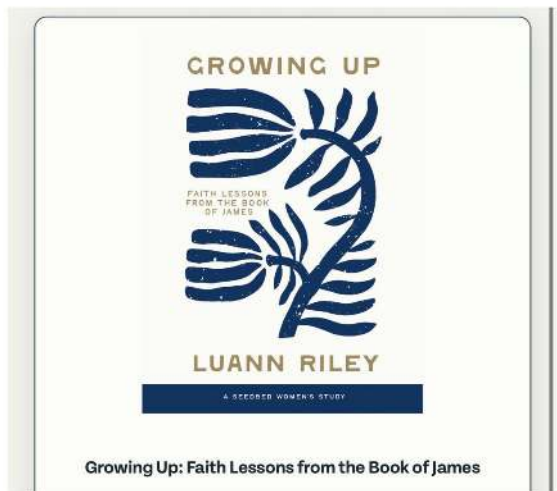


THE CHOSEN

Children and Youth only.

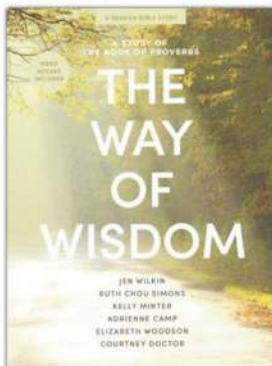
The Children and Youth are meeting

Come and place your feet firmly on the path to life revealed in the book of Proverbs.



“No one lights a lamp and covers it with a jar or puts it under a bed. Instead, he sets it on a stand, so those who enter can see the light.

For there is nothing hidden that will not be disclosed, and nothing concealed that will not be made known and brought to light.”

(Luke 8:16-17)

Jesus call us to lives of *integrity*. It has been said that integrity means doing the right thing even when no one is watching. Jesus confirms this in the passage from Luke 8:16-17. We should live in such a way that our outward actions are honest reflections of our inner self, in Spirit and in Truth.

The journey from a past life of darkness into the new life in Christ requires careful and intentional pruning of the old, spiritual “death” so that we can grow in holy ways that honor and glorify Him!

For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light, for the fruit of the light consists in all goodness, righteousness, and truth.

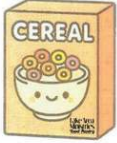
